Professor Efova Mbozo'o v. Pan African Parliament

Brief summary of facts

1. The Applicant, Professor Efova Mbozo'o, is a citizen of the Republic of Cameroon. His employment by the Pan African Parliament (PAP) as a Deputy Clerk was terminated.
2. He alleges that PAP breached his Contract of Employment under the then OAU Staff Regulations and Rules by refusing to renew his contract, and advertising his post even though he had satisfactory evaluation reports.

Relief sought

3. The Applicant requests the Court to annul the decision of PAP by which his contract was not renewed, to order payment of an amount representing salary for the allegedly improperly rescinded contract, compensation for moral and material damages, and that his employment be regarded as of a particular grade from date of recruitment or from January 2007.

Procedure

4. The application was received in the Registry on 6th June, 2011 and registered as Application No. 010/2011.
5. On 7th June, 2011, the Registry confirmed receipt of application by letter referenced AFCHPR/Reg./2011/286.
6. On 25th August, 2011, the Registry received the Applicant's revised request.
