DECLARATION UNDER ARTICLE 34(6) OF THE PROTOCOL TO THE AFRICAN CHARTER ON
HUMAN AND PEOPLES' RIGHTS ON THE ESTABLISHMENT OF THE
AFRICAN COURT ON HUMAN AND PEOPLES' RIGHTS


WHEREAS on the 16th day of July, 2004 Ghana ratified the Protocol to the African Charter on Human and Peoples' Rights on the Establishment of the African Court of Justice

WHEREAS Article 34(6) of the Protocol requires a State Party to make a declaration accepting the competence of the Court to receive cases under Article 5(3) of the Protocol

WHEREAS Article 5(3) of the Protocol stipulates that the Court may entitle relevant Non- Governmental Organisations (NGOs) with observer status before the African Commission and individuals to institute cases directly before it in accordance with Article 34(6)

NOW, therefore, the Republic of Ghana having ratified the Protocol to the African Charter on Human and Peoples' Rights on the Establishment of the African Court on Human and Peoples' Rights hereby declares that it accepts the competence of the Court to receive cases against the Republic of Ghana under Article 5(3) of the Protocol.
